National Voter's Day

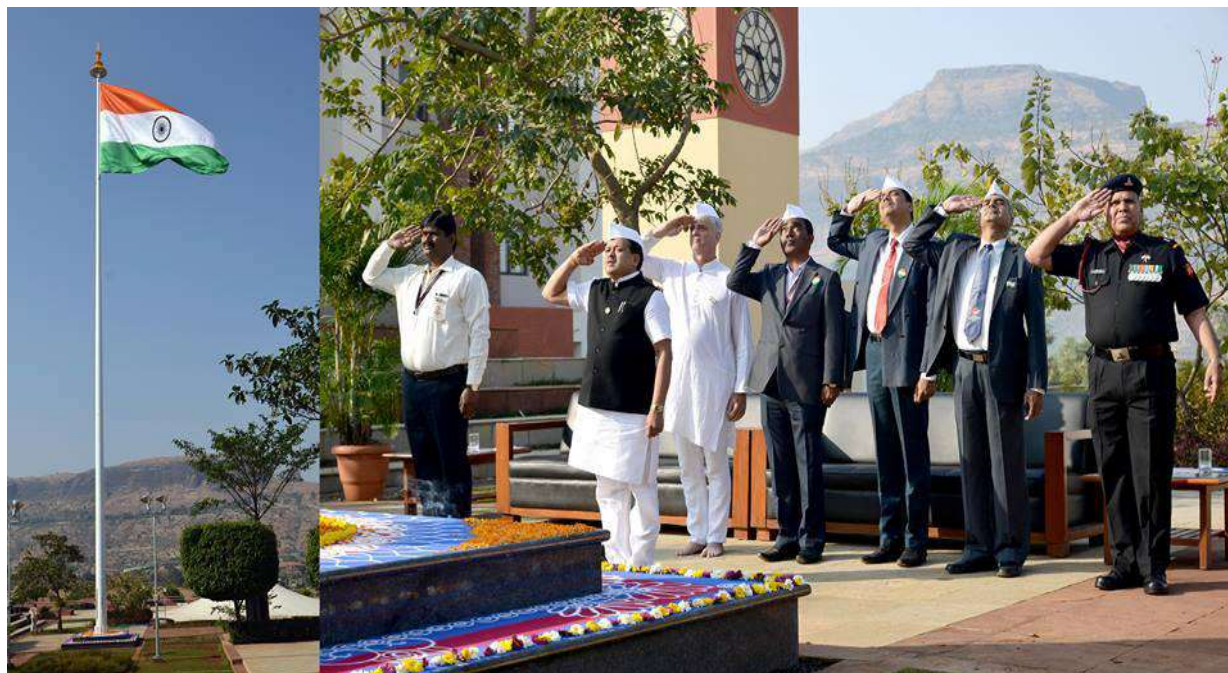
