#### AGREEMENT

#### NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES AGREES AS FOLLOW:

#### 1. Purpose of Agreement:

Each Provider agrees on the terms and conditions of this MOU to collaborate and cooperate with the other in order to coordinate care for Members who are eligible health care services. Nothing herein shall be interpreted to create an exclusive relationship between the Providers, Each Provider shall be free to enter into memorandum of understanding and/or agreements with other entities.

#### 2. Designated Representative:

Each Provider hereby designates a representative ("Designated Representative") to whom all information under this MOU shall be sent and who shall be designated by such Provider to have responsibility to distribute such information to the appropriate employees or other representatives of such Provider for review, action and/or decision. The Designated Representative of each Provider as of the date of this MOU is identified on Attachment (Exhibit) A to this MOU. Each Provider may at any time change its Designated Representative by a notice in writing delivered to the other Provider.

#### 3. Transitional Care Planning.

- (a) The parties acknowledge that Hospital has access to certain information S.K.H for each person who is eligible for health Care reimbursement and who seeks admission or OPD consultation to the Hospital and that such information includes identification of each such Member who has been employee.
- (b) Hospital agrees that when a Member is admitted to the Hospital who is identified through the S.K.H Employee, Hospital agrees to notify the Designated Representative of the Sapkal Knowledge hub of such admission ("Admission Notice"). Such Admission Notice shall be given through mail or in writing and no later than 48 hours after admission. The Admission Notice will be delivered in a form agreed upon by both Parties.
- (c) Following each Admission Notice, each Institution agrees to use good faith efforts to collaborate with the other by exchanging information about the Participant for the purpose of providing a smooth transition for the Participant following his or her discharge from Hospital in order to assist each Provider to provide care for the Participant consistent with such Participant's prior medical background and history.
- (d) Upon discharge by Hospital of any employee, Hospital agrees to deliver to Employee of SKH a discharge summary and his all file, the content and form of which must be agreed upon by both parties.
- (e) free ambulance service to pick up the patients within the corporation limit.

- 05 % discount on OPD medicine,

#### 4. Identification of Potential Participants:

Each institution agrees to collaborate and negotiate with the other in good faith to develop a system whereby Members who are admitted to the emergency department ("ED") of the Hospital who may benefit from becoming a Participant can be identified. Such identification system may include factors such as:

- (a) Selection standards for ED patients to identify those who may benefit from becoming Participants.
- (b) Collaboration between the Providers to develop methods to notify patients admitted to ED of the potential benefits of the SKH Health program.
- (c) Development of a procedure to offer enrollment of employee of SKH to those ED patients who are identified as described above.

#### 5. Billing Arrangements:

All bills incurred with respect to services performed by either Provider for patients pursuant to this MOU shall be collected by the Provider rendering such services directly from the patients as per described discount format or from Sapkal knowledge hub if letter issued by them stating so.

#### 6. Parties' Relationship:

Hospital and Sapkal knowledge hub shall have exclusive control of the management, assets, and affairs of their respective institutions. Each of the parties hereto shall be responsible only for its own acts and omissions with respect to patient care, and neither party by virtue of this Agreement assumes any liability for any debts or obligations of either a financial or a legal nature incurred by the other party to this Agreement.

#### 7. Term:

This Agreement shall be effective for the period beginning 09th September 2017 for a term of two year, and thereafter it shall be renewed automatically for successive periods of Two year, unless sooner terminated as herein provided. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement may be terminated by either party for any reason after the expiration of the first full year of the term hereof by giving thirty days' prior written notice to the other party of its intention to withdraw from this Agreement and by ensuring the continuity of care to patients who already are involved in the transfer process.

#### 8. Notices:

Any notices permitted or required by this Agreement will be deemed made on the day personally delivered in writing or mailed by certified mail, postage prepaid, to the other

#### PREAMBLE

- Appreciating the need for creation of large reservoir of highly qualified manpower in all fields related to Pharmaceutical sciences.
- Desiring to club their efforts by pooling their expertise and resources intended to form a nucleus for promoting excellent quality manpower in the fields of pharmacy with special emphasis on advance analytical techniques and related fields etc.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises made herein and of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which both RGSCOP and

NRPL hereby acknowledges, RGSCOP and NRPL hereby agree to sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU).

#### ARTICLE-I: SCOPE OF THE MOU

This MOU details the modalities and general conditions regarding collaboration between

RGSCOP and NRPL for enhancing, within the country, the availability of highly qualified manpower in the areas of analytical technologies without any prejudice to prevailing rules and regulations in RGSCOP and NRPL without any disregard to any mechanism evolved and approved by the competent NRPL. The areas of cooperation can be extended through mutual consent.

#### ARTICLE-II: SCOPE OF ACADEMIC INTERACTIONS

Both RGSCOP and NRPL shall encourage interaction between the Scientists, Research fellows, faculty members and students of both the organizations through the following arrangements:

- a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars,
- c) Practical training of RGSCOP students at NRPL. Two Training Program under NRPL Viz.


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






## MANAGEMENT OF THE VARIOUS TYPES OF DEGRADABLE AND NON-DEGRADABLE WASTE

- RED DUSTBINS: It is used for non-biodegradable waste. Because these wastes cannot be recycled, it is also regarded as rejecting dustbin. It is typically used in hospitals to collect biomedical waste, which includes needles, surgical knives, body fluids, cotton dressings, pop casts, tissues, sanitary napkins, and other items that must be disposed of carefully.
- ✓ GREEN DUSTBINS: It is used to dispose of wet and biodegradable waste. It is also known
  as an organic bin because it contains waste from the kitchen, plants, and animals. Rotten
  eggs, fruits, vegetables and peels, coconut shells, tea bags, used tea powder, leftover food,
  garden waste, and so on are examples of these wastes. Organic waste is also used in the
  kitchen garden as manure to grow vegetables. Some of these wastes are sterilized and fed to
  animals, while farmers use the remainder for manure and composting, which improves soil
  fertility. Composting converts this waste to zero waste.

Plastic, aluminum cans, polystyrene, newspapers, paints, nerosol cans, lights, broken bulbs, glass bottles, plastic bottles, gift wrappers, cards, cardboards, thermal coal, tetra pack packaging, and other materials should be discarded in this bin.




