Discipline is a way of life at RGSCOP. The institute takes utmost care for safety and security of women in the campus by the provision of different facilities and awareness steps amongst the students. It is ensured through installation of CCTV surveillance cameras throughout the institute premises and campus. Also, it is available at all entry gates, entry gate of girls and boys hostels, entry gate of college building, parking areas and canteen. The rectors/ Wardens in the hostels, security guards ensure safety of the students. The security guards are assigned with strict instructions to report any misbehavior case(s) in the campus and hostels. Any unidentified entry and exit is well observed as per the protocol of the institute. After office hours, the college campus is well illuminated with sufficient required light for ensuring the safety during night hours. The institute has also constituted 'Internal Complaint Committee', women's grievance cell and antiragging committee. The institute ICC has been directed to effectively utilize social media specially Whats App for forming groups for help and suggestions. Mentor- Mentee system effectively is in place for group of students to pay attention to problems and safety of students. Girl's common provides all essential facilitates including first aid box, sanitary napkin



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dispensing/vending machine, hand dryer, handwash dispenser, bed, light, fan, lockers and incinerator. To maintain the hygiene, a separate spacious common rooms and rest rooms are available for boys and girl. In all major areas institute is provided with fire safety equipment and water purifier system on each floor. In college premises the staff and the students are expected to wear their ID cards. For equality both boys and girl students have same uniform. This helps in implementing the awareness and security amongst the staff and the students. The college provides equal opportunity to females and males with respect to freedom of movement and participation in various organizing committees. They perform activities in groups during practical experiments, educational tours, and industrial visits. Special sports events are organized for girls such as cricket, volley ball etc. College organize various activities like sport event, cultural activities, co-curricular activities such as workshop, training development programs for employability, personality development, and skill development. As a result RGSCOP has witnessed increased enrolment of girls.



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




