National Voter's Day



First Day

Writing history of the village and compilation of historical architecture

On the first day of the camp, the campers in the morning NSS Lyrics as well as with the singing of the national anthem.

All the campers were first cleaned the Gram Panchayat area and Hanuman temple in the village and then interacted with the village girls and informed about the activities to be implemented under the camp.

Also the campers were divided into groups and a group leader was selected for each group. Each group collected information about the village and its ancient temples and information about the crops grown in the village, the family's livelihood sources, etc.

Also, the area of Hanuman temple in village was cleaned by campers and it is the opinion of village experts that lord Hanuman was born in Anjaneri. The temple of Anjani Mata, the birthplace of Hanuman, came near Anjaneri Fort. On the right side of Anjaneri, Dhamanyagad and Karvandara are also such beautiful forts. On the left side is the Trimbakeshwar mountain range. River Godavari originates at Trimbakeshwar. One of the twelve Jyotirlingas is at Trimbakeshwar. Anjaneri village has ruins of temples dating back to about 2000 to 3000 years ago. The Department of Archeology has surveyed them. In this way, the campers got to know the history of Hanuman birth and Anjani fort and under this scheme, it was decided to try to eliminate superstitions by highlighting this in the seven days of the camp to get the idea that some superstitions are still in the village. Also, the people of the village still have to depend on the water from the well for drinking water.

After getting all the information, the campers were happy about the problems in the village and the living conditions and facilities of education there.

Second day

Personal, household and environmental hygiene

National Service Scheme Campers second day started as usual. On the third day, the campers interacted with the students from classes 1 to 7 of Zilla Parishad Primary School in the village. Also in Sonai Secondary School Dr. G. B. Jadhav gave information about health and environment.

The campers selected one class each of the school students and spoke to them about personal hygiene, household hygiene and environmental hygiene. The campers convinced the students of the school about the importance of going to school every day. At the end of the day, the campers cleaned the school premises.

The temple of Anjanimat on Anjaneri Fort and its surroundings were cleaned. From the base of the fort to the summit, under the plastic free Anjaneri campaign, plastic waste, plastic bags were collected and the Maruti birth place was cleaned.

Third day

Health Camps and Health Lectures

On the third day, Swasth and Swachh Bharat Day was celebrated under the health camp. On this day, the campers took the permission of the school teacher and informed the school students about health and various diseases. In it, daily health care like washing hands with soap after defecation, cutting nails and other good habits were guided.

In personal hygiene, the students were guided about the diseases caused by dirt accumulated in the nails by checking the nails of the students and distributing them nail cutters. Also in the afternoon session, Dr. Milind Patil gave a lecture on AIDS. In that regard, the villagers asked Dr. Milind Patil given knowledge about Hitguj AIDS. Also, hand hygiene awareness morning walk was organized on the day.

Day 4

Tree Plantation

On the fourth day, in the morning, the campers cleaned the area of Hanuman Birthplace Anjaneri Fort and planted a total of 54 plants of medicinal plants and distributed grass tea plants to the villagers. After planting the trees, the campers told the villages the scientific information about the tree, erratic rainfall, global warming and its uses and the health benefits of herbal tea.

The village girls also actively participated in the tree plantation discussion and gave a good response. Also at 03.00 pm Dr. R. S. Bachchav gave information about the importance of environment and plantation of trees and in that he did some demonstrations in front of the village girls.

Fifth day

To implement activities on youth empowerment

On the fifth day of the national service scheme camp, the campers organized a quiz on youth empowerment. While the campers had scope for exchange of ideas, before the fifth activities, they visited the Hanuman temple on Historic Anjaneri fort in the village and sought blessings for the youth empowerment.

In the meantime, the students participated in the Gandhi Thought discussion session of the village to know how the previous thoughts and Gandhian thoughts are complementary to the National Service Scheme. Also at 02.30 pm Dr. A. B. Darekar gave a lecture on Swami Vivekananda and Today's Youth. In it, he guided today's youth on how to be perfect.

The rate of participation in self-government organizations is increasing today. A woman is doing the same thing as a man by participating in active politics. It is helping to empower women. On this day, an eye diagnosis camp was organized in association with Maya Superspeciality Hospital, Nashik in the village community temple. A large number of villagers participated in the said camp.

The seventh day

History of Adopted Village

Anjaneri T. Trimbakeshwar, Dist. Nashik-422212

Kalyani Charitable Trust's Ravindra Gambhirrao Sapkal College of Pharmacy, Anjaneri, Nashik for the National Service Scheme Anjaneri T. Trimbakeshwar, Dist. Nashik is an adopted village. The said camp dt. 23/12/2017 to dt. 29/12/2017 carried out enthusiastically during the period.

Also the campers were divided into groups among the students and a group leader was selected for each group. Each group gathered information about the village and its ancient temples and information about the crops grown in the village as a source of family livelihood. Among them Anjaneri is an important fort in Trimbakeshwar region and Nashik city is one of the best attractions. Situated at 4264 feet above sea level, Anjaneri is a spiritual place between Nashik and Trimbakeshwar. Anjaneri is the birth place. Hanuman had his childhood and upbringing on the same mountain. One hundred and eight Jain caves dating back to the 12th century are found here.

Also, the area of Hanuman temple in village was cleaned by campers and it is the opinion of village experts that Hanuman was born in Anjaneri. The temple of Anjani Mata, the birthplace of Hanuman, came near Anjaneri Fort. On the right side of Anjaneri there are beautiful forts like Dhamanyagad and Karavadara. On the left side is the Trimbakeshwar mountain range. River Godavari originates at Trimbakeshwar. One of the twelve Jyotirlings is at Trimbakeshwar. Anjaneri village has ruins of temples dating back to about 2000 to 3000 years ago. The Department of Archeology has surveyed them. In this way, the campers got to know the history of Hanuman birth and Anjani Gad and under this scheme, it was decided to try to eliminate superstitions by highlighting this in the seven days of the camp to get the idea that some superstitions are still in the village. Also, the people of the village still have to depend on the water from the well for drinking water.

After receiving all the information, the campers were happy about the problems in the village and the living conditions and facilities of education there.
